EYES ON NIGERIA: UNVEILING THE CRISIS

Nigeria ranks eighth (8th) on the Global Terrorism Index 2023 (GTI ReliefWeb) and Sixth (6th) on Open Doors World Watch List 2023 of the countries in which Christians are most persecuted. By comparison, Afghanistan, a country at war, ranks 9th.

Despite this fact, terrorism and Christian persecution in Nigeria has not yet received the international attention as other regions featured in these lists.

PSJUK is dedicated to cutting through the clutter of disinformation with reliable, credible, timely evidence and data. Our research hub and 'incident tracker' are credible sources for verified information on the Nigerian insecurity crisis.

VICTIM ACCOUNTS



On 20 January 2020, the **Abubakar Shekau faction of Boko Haram** executed the **chair of the Christian Association of Nigeria in Adamawa state**, Reverend Lawan Andimi



On Boxing Day 2019, a Christian bride-to-be and her entire bridal party were **massacred while traveling in Adamawa state** to prepare for her New Years' Eve wedding... **her sister Zainab and five others were ritually slaughtered...."they were beheaded by suspected Boko Haram insurgents at Gwoza on their way to her country home"** says witness.

VICTIM ACCOUNTS



Veronica, from Dogon Noma, said: “Another man attacked me with a machete twice, once to the neck and once to my hand. I was so confused. I lost consciousness. **When I woke up, I saw my daughter on ground – she was dead – with my chopped finger in her mouth.**”



Antonia Aje, from Karamai, said: “I saw my brother-in-law’s **body on the ground, hacked to pieces by a machete...** Our home is destroyed. The hospital was burnt. **They tried to burn the roof of the church by piling up the chairs, like a bonfire.**”



The Institute for Economics and Peace published figures in their Global Terrorism Index that Fulani Militants are **responsible for more deaths than Boko Haram since 2015.**

On August 10th, 2023, **gunmen believed to be Muslim Fulani herdsmen** attacked the Heipang community in **Barkin Ladi Local Government Area** of Plateau State, Middlebelt Nigeria, killing 21 Christians and injuring more than a dozen others.

In April 2023, during the holy week preceding Easter, **Islamic extremists** attacked villages in **Apa, Otukpo, and Guma local government areas** of **Benue State**, Middlebelt Nigeria and killed over 130 Christians, wounded dozens, and displaced thousands.



In 2018, **14-year old Leah Sharibu** was abducted by Islamist extremists from her school in Dapchi, north-east Nigeria. She was denied her freedom for refusing to convert from Christianity to Islam as a precondition for her release. Reports say that she's been enslaved, raped and impregnated, giving birth to a child.

On September 7th, **Islamic extremists** attacked the **parish house of St. Rachael's Catholic Church** in **Fadan Kamantan**, Zangon Kataf Local Government Area of Kaduna State and set the building on fire. A seminarian, Brother Na'aman Danladi was killed in the fire. A Christian leader in the area said: "The parish is located at the heart of the town and the attack was carried out at about 8pm. This causes us to wonder some more: where is the hope, how much more terrible could the situation get?"

Armed men suspected to be **bandits** murdered **Catholic priest, Rev Fr. Vitus Borogo**, in Kaduna State. The incident happened on Saturday at the Prison Farm, Kujama, along Kaduna-Kachia Road, after a raid on the farm. Rev Fr. Vitus was also the Chairman of the Nigerian Catholic Diocesan Priests Association (NCDPA), Kaduna Chapter.

On a Sunday in June 2023, **21 Christians including one pastor** were killed in communities in **Riyom Local Government Area of Plateau State**, Middlebelt Nigeria, by Muslim herders who claim to have done so in retaliation of the killings of two herders found in the area.
